Dear Parents and Families,

I am pleased to say we are in our final stages of our preparations for *full opening in September* across our three schools. I can assure you that we will be following the guidance published by the government, as well as additional guidance from the Diocese of Ely Multi-Academy Trust to ensure that all our processes are in line with national expectations. It has been made clear that *everyone is expected to return to school in September*.

Our risk assessments are currently being evaluated, and will be published on The Trinity Partnership website as soon as possible. They will include the following actions:

- All pupils will be expected to return to school and will remain in class bubbles with their new classes to reduce contact with other children. There will be 4 class bubbles in total (Reception, Y1-2, Y3-4, Y5-6).
- Regular handwashing will take place on arrival, after playtimes, before lunch, after PE, after going to toilet.
- Pupils will be entering and exiting school via outside classroom doors. Although times of the school day will return to normal, we will adopt a 'soft start' to the school day with children coming straight into classes once the gates are open (around 10 minutes before the start of the school day).
- Staggered break and lunchtimes, and playground will be zoned into two areas for two bubbles at a time.
- Soft start at the end of break and lunch- no lining up.
- There will be class assemblies only instead of whole school Collective Worship.
- Toilets to be used by one pupil at a time, and queuing to be at a suitable distance. Toilets will be used throughout the day, rather than mainly at break times.

Expectations for school uniform will return to normal from September, and all items should be named please. Our uniform policy is as follows:

- Sweatshirt (Duchy- blue, Norman- red, Weeting- green)
- White polo shirt
- Grey school trousers or skirt
- Black shoes
- PE Kit (in named bag): plain white or school logo t-shirt, black shorts, trainers or plimsolls
- Long hair to be tied back please,

Please see updated diary dates at the back of the newsletter. Please note that unfortunately, some events usually involving large gatherings, e.g. Harvest Festival, may not be open to parents this year.
